- **Dr. Carlson People's Choice Award**— People's favorite float entry.

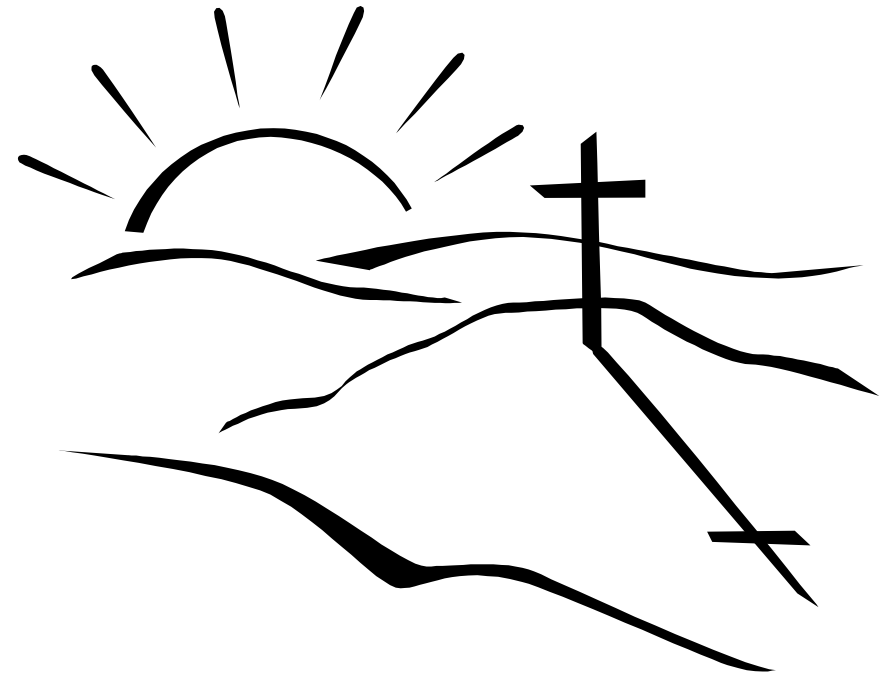
