BIBLESTA FLOAT RULES

Theme: Floats and walking entries are to depict a story or scripture for the Bible. All floats are encouraged to have people included in portraying their float theme. The committee allows one float or walking entry per Biblical scripture. Please complete the enclosed float registration form as soon as possible to assure your chosen scripture as floats are on a first come first serve basis for scripture selection.

Costumes: All participants on floats or walking entries must wear Biblical costumes. Marching bands, color guards, and support personnel (like drivers) not a part of the float are not required to wear costumes. Biblical costumes are very important.

Lettering: The title of your entry and scripture reference should be printed in 6-inch letters. Please include the scripture reference on both sides of the float. The name of the float entrant should also be on the float.

Height: Floats should be no taller than **14 ½ feet** in order to clear the overhead electrical wires along the parade route.

Parade Lineup: Floats must be in the parade lineup at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday. Walking entries must be in the parade lineup at 12:45 p.m. The parade lineup will be in chronological order as the events happened in the Bible.

Please note: Because of safety concerns, please refrain from tossing items, such as candy, out along the parade route.
