

BIBLESTA FOOD CONCESSION SPACE REQUEST

The registration deadline is Friday, September 16, 2022.

Vendors may begin setting up booths on October 1, 2022, at 7:30 a.m. and may continuing selling until 5:00 p.m.

As a non-profit organization food concession space vendor, I agree to the following guidelines established by the Biblesta Committee (please carefully).

1. Food concession vendors serving meals must provide a **float or walking entry** in the Biblesta Parade. The float registration must be included with this request to assure a food concession space be reserved for your group. The parade entry will meet all requirements as determined by the Biblesta float Rules.
2. Food concession vendors providing only bake sale items (breads, pies, etc.) must provide a **float, walking entry, or window display**. The float or window display registration must be included with this request to assure a concession space.
3. It is recommended concession booths using grills have a fire extinguisher available. Concession spaces are to be always kept clean. Trash receptacles are in the park for your convenience.
4. A non-refundable registration fee of \$50.00 is required to reserve a concession space. In addition, **ALL** vendors are required to pay 10% of the net income received from sales to the Biblesta Committee within 30 days after the Biblesta event. The \$50.00 registration fee can be included in the 10%.
5. Food concession spaces with electrical hook-ups are limited to a 15-amp GFI circuit. Check your small appliances to make sure they do not exceed 15 amps. Please make sure your extension cords are 14- or 12- gauge wire, in good working condition and are dry when inserted into outlet. Electrical cords crossing sidewalks must be taped down to avoid accidents.

****NOTE: GENERATORS ARE NOT ALLOWED.**

****ALSO NOTE: Food vendors will not be able to have their booths in any part of the street, this includes tables, grills, fuel supplies etc. Any vehicles will need to be removed from closed streets, including Bridge Street, before 11:00 a.m.**

6. "ALL" FOOD CONCESSIONS MUST STOP SELLING AT 1:30 P.M.! You may resume selling as soon as the last parade entry passes New York Street (south side of square).
